# Under the Sea!


This term our topic is called 'Under the Sea'. A fantastic topic all about the seaside and the oceans of the world. Over the course of the term the children will be learning all about the different features you can find at the seaside. They will also be exploring what an island is, how we can get to an island and what the 5 oceans are called. In Science the children will be exploring different types of animals, including animals we can keep as pets and wild animals. The children will also be exploring animal's diets and what they eat, using the words carnivore, omnivore and herbivore to describe what kind of eater



they are. In P.E. we will be practising our running throwing and jumping skills to get us ready for our sports day! In RE the children are thinking about 'Our Wonderful World' and the Christian creation story. In PSHE the children will be

exploring what money is, where money comes from and how we can spend

money. We will be going for a walk to the local shop to carry out a simple transaction.





## Personal Belongings

Please can you make sure that everything (including jumpers, forest school kit, wellies, PE kits and trainers) are clearly labelled with your child's name so we are able to return any lost items to the



correct child. If your child has an item of clothing which is not named, it is very difficult to return it to the correct owner. ### Homework

#### Reading Books

#### Sharing Book

Your child will change their sharing book on a <u>Monday and Wednesday</u>. Please ensure your child brings their sharing book back to school on both of these days so they can be changed.

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#### Phonics Book

Your child will read with their reading teacher every day. Your child will bring their new phonics book home on a Friday. Please make sure your child's previous phonics book is in school on the <u>Friday morning</u>, so we are able to issue their new one.
