Summer Term 2

Welcome to the final term of the school year! Although we are working from home, we will be following what the school bubbles are doing. Topic

This term in in Central Class our theme is The Commonwealth and we are focussing on the world map, continents and oceans and also where the commonwealth fits in! We will continue this theme with our **DT** work, looking at different aspects of the Commonwealth such as traditional dress and food.

Reading and Literacy

Even though we are working from home, it is really important to keep reading different books. We will use books as a starting point for our learning but we encourage you to read lots of different books with your grown-ups.

Our first book is 'The Tempest' by William Shakespeare, we will be exploring this story and writing a newspaper report based on the story. Our second book is 'Just so stories' by Rudyard Kiplin – we will be using this book to write our own story.

<u>Maths</u>

Year 3 - We are starting off the term by looking at formal multiplication and then going onto working with fractions. We will continue using Busy Ant maths as well as challenging ourselves through reasoning and problem-solving challenges and daily arithmetic.

Year 4 - Children will be recapping all that has been learnt in mathematics in the previous terms. They will be covering most areas of the mathematics curriculum but extending their learning to apply their knowledge to reasoning and problem solving and greater depth. Children will be reviewing four operations, fractions, measurement, geometry, algebra and statistics.

RE, PSHE and Science

This term, we are thinking about Big Questions like 'What makes a good life?' and 'Does God exist?' Is the meaning of a good life the same for everybody? In PHSE, we are focussing on economic well-being and in **Science** we are learning about plants and the plant life cycle.

It is really important to keep healthy and active in lock down and alongside your daily walks, we will encourage you to join in with Joe Wicks each morning.
