We welcome you back to school after the last few months of home schooling. I know there may be uncertainty, worry and a sense of anxiousness, but please be assured we are doing all health and safety measures to keep your children safe.

## <u>Our Curriculum</u>

This term in our Hyde 'Bubble', we are going to try and have a sense of normality by planning lessons like we would usually. **In History**, we are going to focus on Walls and Barricades. We will be using this to create a mixture of historical and geographical lessons for the children, learning about famous structures both past and current of the world.

In Literacy, our first book that we are focusing on this term is 'The Legend of Heracles'. This book is a fantastic opportunity for children to develop positive attitudes to reading by increasing their familiarity fiction. Our reading may look a little different this term, we will still be able to access Accelerated Reader but we only have a few iPads so it may take a little longer. Children will not be accessing the library.

**Maths** – We are starting off the term by looking at addition and subtraction (Y4&5) and ratio and proportion (Y6). We will continue using Busy Ant maths as well as challenging ourselves through reasoning and problem-solving challenges and daily arithmetic.

**RE, PHSE, DT, Science**– This term, we are going to focus on Judaism and look deeper into the religion, how it originated, traditions and beliefs. In PHSE, we will be focusing on money and how to use it appropriately, but we will also be completing many lessons which support positive mental health and well-being, especially during the first couple of weeks. In DT, we are

going to be designing, and branding our own cereal bars and finally in Science we are going to explore Sound! **PE** - We will be taking on a curriculum area with JB Sports on a **Thursday** afternoon. Children **can** come into school on this day wearing P.E kit.
