Welcome to the final term of the school year! Although we are working from home, we will be following what the school bubbles are doing. <u>Topic</u>

This term in in Phoenix Class our theme is "Walls and Barricades". We will explore the idea of barriers – both physical (The Great Wall of China, Hadrian's Wall) and political and how people can work together to break them down, including prejudice and discrimination. We will think about important historical figures who fought for change such as Martin Luther King and Rosa Parks.

Reading and Literacy

Even though we are working from home, it is really important to keep reading different books. We will use books as a starting point for our learning but we encourage you to read lots of different books with your grown-ups. We will use our topic as a basis for our learning, looking at persuasive writing and writing speeches and biographies.

<u>Maths</u>

Children will be recapping all that has been learnt in mathematics in the previous terms. They will be covering most areas of the mathematics curriculum but extending their learning to apply their knowledge to reasoning and problem solving and greater depth. Children will be reviewing four operations, fractions, measurement, geometry, algebra and statistics.

RE, PSHE and Science

This term, in RE, we are learning about the faith of Judaism – thinking about, amongst other themes, their places of worship, prayer rituals and rites of passage.
