Welcome to the final term of the school year! Although we are working from home, we will be following what the school bubbles are doing. Topic

This term in Regents Class our theme is "We Are Going on a Summer Holiday" and in our topic learning we are going to travel all around the world, learning about the oceans and continents. We will learn to use journey lines to map an imaginary journey around the world and, closer to home, we will learn about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom and their capital cities.

#### **Reading and Literacy**

Even though we are working from home, it is really important to keep reading different books. We will use books as a starting point for our learning but we encourage you to read lots of different books with your grown-ups. In English lessons we are thinking about traditional tales such as The Three Little Pigs and those with a twist like "Prince Cinders" and "Hoodwinked". We will write character and setting descriptions, create story maps and write our own versions of the stories.

#### **Maths**

In Maths we will continue to practice our skills across all four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and learn more about fractions, shape and time.

#### <u>RE</u>

In RE we are thinking about special places in particular we are looking at Jewish synagogues and Christian churches. We will think about how Jews and Christians pray and worship and look closely at Christian baptism and holy

## communion.

### <u>Science</u>

In science we are learning about plants in the world around us. It will give you the chance to enjoy the natural world on your daily walks and in your gardens. We will learn about the different parts of a plant and what a plant needs to grow healthily. We look forward to seeing your work and maybe even some pictures of the plants in your garden.

#### Art

In art this term we will be thinking about Caribbean art, with a focus on the artist Heleen Cornet. We will create beach dioramas and learn about carnivals, making our own carnival masks.
