Our Curriculum

This term in our Regent's 'Bubble', we are going to try and have a sense of normality by following structured lessons.

Our topic, this term, in **Geography** is Around the World. The children will explore the world map, focussing on continents, oceans and the United Kingdom.

Our Art will be based on exploring a range of colourful art from the West Indies.

In **English**, the children will be looking at a range of traditional tales on the IWB to support our writing activities. Children **will not** be accessing the library so please try to read daily with your children at home to enable them to still have the joy of books. The children will have a spelling test on a **Wednesday** morning.

In **Maths**, the children are starting off the term by looking at addition and subtraction and word problems. They will continue using Busy Ant Maths as well as being challenged through reasoning and problem-solving challenges and daily mental maths problems.

In RE, the children will be looking at Jewish and Christian places of worship and exploring their practice of worship.

In **PHSE**, we will be focusing on emotions, feelings and what makes us special and unique. We will also be completing many lessons which support positive mental health and well-being, especially during the first couple of weeks.

In Science the children are learning about plants and the plant life cycle.

In **PE** the children will be completing active challenges with JB Sports on a **Friday** afternoon. The children should come into school on this day wearing P.E kit. As PE will take place outside, please send your children in wearing outdoor PE kit.
