


As places are limited the school places an expectation of both attendance and high standards of behaviour on all those enrolled. If children consistently fail to attend or their behaviour falls below what is considered acceptable, their place may be offered to a child currently on the waiting list.

While currently we are able to continue to offer most of our clubs at no cost this may not always be the case, and it may be necessary to re-introduce charging in future terms. Please ensure that your child is collected promptly at the end of each club.

Messages are sent out to notify parents of this and where this is not possible a telephone call will be made or a message placed on Class Dojo.
