Mr Cowdell will be joining both Sutterton and Swineshead as the area site manager for the schools and will support with our compliance checks.

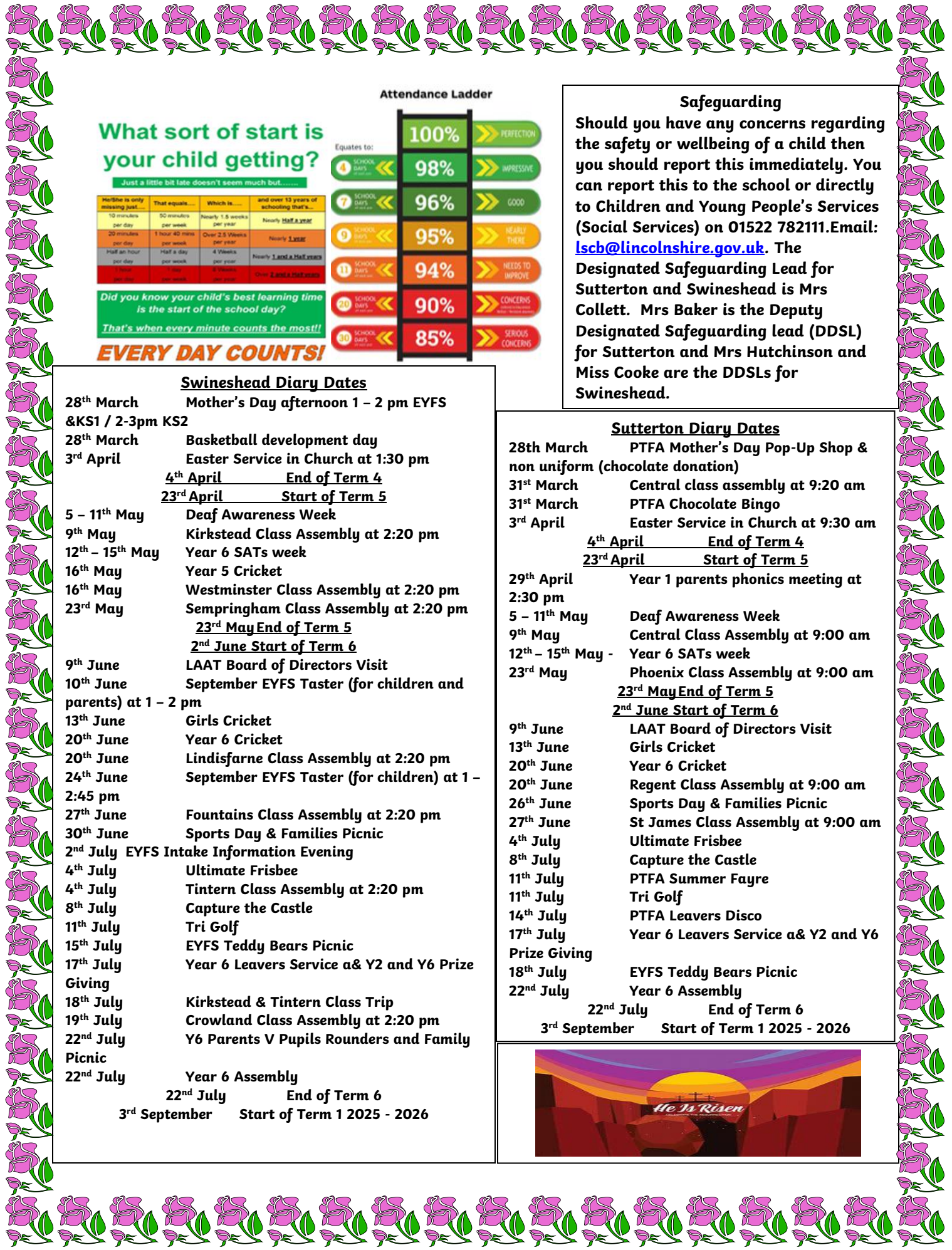
### School Vision
