The following roles were proposed and seconded.

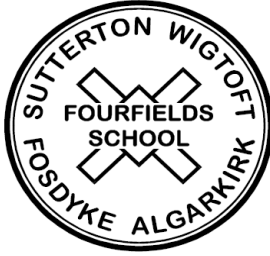
