### **Forest School**



- All children in reception have access to the Forest School Provision once a week in small groups for a 90 minute session.
- Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process.
- Forest School fosters confident, independent and creative learners by providing children with a range of experiences linked to their individual interests.
- Children will participate in a range of activities including; den building, woodland crafts, safe use of age-appropriate tools, building and cooking on an open fire, observe and respond to local flora and fauna in the environment and much more!

## **Family Workshops**

- Each term we invite parents and carers into school to take part in a family workshop.
- These workshops enable you to see how we support your child's learning in the 7 areas of learning.
- We host a range of activities for you and your child to participate in with a clear learning intention.










### Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised

### Our Transition Programme

- Pre-School visits from our EYFS Team.
- Two open afternoons for your child in the Summer Term one with you and one without.
- 'Going to school' morning children visit school with their pre-school key workers
- Information evening for parents
- Invitation to Christmas Nativities and Sports Day

#### <u>September</u>

- Children start school full time from the first day if children require further transition we can support this with a phased transition to school.
- Tapestry Workshop introduction to Tapestry and the opportunity to get signed up!
- Invitation to your child's key worker to come and see the how the children have settled into 'big school'.
