Dear Parents/Carers,

Our learning continues at the Emmaus Federation as the children start their topic work for term 6. It's an opportunity for more outdoors learning and the infant children at Sutterton have already been on a beach adventure and have flown a simulated aircraft this week and the reception children at Swineshead have been busy with lots of messy play, looking at the properties of materials and planning alien space adventures!

The term is filled with lots of sporting activities and the chance to compete and (hopefully) win some silverware. The recent KS2 rounders event at Boston High School was a fantastic event that was well organised and gave us the chance to compete against a wide variety of schools. Both schools competed well and displayed excellent team-work skills. Sutterton entered the rounders club team, which consisted predominantly of year 4 and year 5 players. They really equipped themselves well and were in the play-off for first place against Tower Road although succumbed to a very capable squad in their final deciding game. The cricket competition was also dominated by Emmaus teams with a second place Swineshead conceding three runs to Sutterton's first place win and county selection.

In the future, we would like to ensure that Swineshead turn-up to competition events in a professional squad kit.
